Paul Hibbard (son of Paul Millard) and family; stated age (33) matches listed DOB of Feb. 1827

G.S. (George) Hibbard (son of Paul Millard) and family; stated age (46) suggests DOB of Nov. 1814, instead of 1816. I have noted cases where birthdays are counted as of the current year, regardless of actual month.

Rebecca Hibbard (daughter of Ahimaaz); stated age (90) matches listed DOB of Oct. 1789

Warren G. Hibbard (son of Paul Millard) and family; stated age (39) suggests DOB of Mar. 1821, instead of 1818

Hiram Hibbard (son of Paul Millard) and family; stated age (30) suggests DOB of Nov. 1829, instead of 1828
Sally Hibbard (wife of Paul Millard and mother of all these men) living with youngest son, Hiram

One interesting note is that the dwelling numbers are 643, 644 (Paul, George) and 646, 647 (Warren, Hiram) which indicates all four families lived either next door or in close proximity. Not surprising at all.

A curious note is the name of John S. Bates, age 23, farmer, living with George's family. Perhaps a hired hand to help work the farm.
