¹ Hebard – Other examples of the enumerator’s (census taker) handwriting on the same page indicates this spelling. The “a” is very close to the writer’s “u”, but the slight curve at the beginning indicates an “a”. The “e” slight hook at the top can be seen in the names “George”, “Vermont” and “New” York in this example.
