I N the loss or absence of many State and National Records bearing upon the American Navy in the Revolutionary War, the roll of Connecticut men in this branch of the service can at present be prepared only in incomplete form. Two Log Books of Privateer Brigantine "Marquis de La Fayette" Elisha Hinman, Commander. 1st Voyage. Bound to the West Indies, Oct. 10, 1782.

2nd Voyage. Bound to Virginia, thence to Amsterdam, Feb. 11, 1783.

Prizes Captured, viz.: Brigantine "Phoenix"; Brigantine "Dispatch"; Sloop "British Grenadier."
